

Central City High School Graduation Requirements (2-20-2018)

Graduation Requirements for CCHS students are outlined below. Within the 230 semester credit hour requirements for graduation, a student must have successfully completed credit hours in specific courses, which total 160 semester credit hours.

English (40 credits)

CCHS Courses: Reading (IEP); English I; English II; English III or American Literature; English IV or British Literature

Science (30 credits)

CCHS Courses: Applied Physical Science or Physical Science; Applied Biology or Biology; Applied Chemistry or Environmental Science plus Earth and Space Science; or Chemistry, or Advanced Biology, or Physics, or another Science course

Mathematics (30 credits)

CCHS Courses: Basic Math Skills (IEP); Basic Algebra or Alg I (Team) or Algebra I; Basic Geometry or Geom (Team) or Geometry; Intermediate Algebra or Algebra II; or a Mathematics course that builds upon a completed Mathematics course

Social Science (30 credits)

CCHS Courses for Class of 2019, 2020: 10 cr American History; 5 cr World History; 5 cr American Government; 5 cr Geography; and 5 more credits of World History or another Social Science course

CCHS Courses for Class of 2021 and after: 10 cr World Cultures; 5 cr World History; 10 cr American History; and 5 cr Government

Physical Education (5 credits)

CCHS Courses: Physical Education; Fitness Training; Lifetime Fitness; or related course

Health (5 credits)

CCHS Course: Health

Art, Music, and/or Communications (5 credits)

CCHS Courses: Concert Choir; Band; Art; Spanish; Leadership; Advanced Leadership; Intro to Drama, Forensics, or related course

Quarter Classes (5 credits)

CCHS Courses: Speech and Personal Finance (Junior year)

Technology (10 credits)

CCHS Courses Class of 2019, 2020: Must complete Word Processing and Information Technology App I

CCHS Courses Class of 2021 and after: Must complete Information Technology App I (Prerequisite – Word Processing course; or have a speed of 20 or more net words per minute) In addition must complete one of the following 5 cr courses: Word Processing; Graphic Art; Computer Aided Manufacturing; Bison Productions; Yearbook; Music Production; Information Technology Applications II; or related course.

Electives (70 credits, from courses not used to meet specific graduation requirements)

Job Shadowing (Total of 6 clock hours, or 3 clock hours if entering CCHS as a senior)

Community Service (Total of 20 clock hours for the Class of 2021 and after) (Total of 15 clock hours for the Class of 2020) (Total of 10 clock hours for the Class of 2019) (or an average of 5 clock hours per year upon entering CCHS)
