6029.5 National Activity Trips

The Central City Public Schools understands that National Activity Trips can provide students with extended educational opportunities. National Trips must comply with Board Policy 6027 and 6029. In addition, students must comply with the board's policies on field trips as well as the student code of conduct, the extracurricular code, and all directives of a sponsor or chaperone while on an activity trip. The superintendent, or designee, may prohibit any student who misbehaves while on school-sponsored trips from attending future trips.

National Activity Trips are understood to be privilege. а Organizations/Activities will have the opportunity for National Trips and these trips will be planned and organized to provide students with educational opportunities that are an extension of their organization/activity. National Trips will require the organization/activity to provide fundraising opportunities for students to offset some or all of the costs incurred for their participation in the trip. Further, fundraising activities shall be conducted to pay for the required expenses of the sponsors for the trip. Understanding that National Activity Trips necessitate outside fundraising, National Activity Trips will be restricted to minimize the number of fundraising activities that take place within the community.

All national activity trips must be approved by administration and approved by the Board of Education. In addition, all fundraising activities must be approved by the administration and no fundraising will begin without permission provided by the administration.

To properly manage the number of National Activity Trips, the following schedule has been created for organizations that currently schedule National Activity Trips. Musical National Trips will take place in the summer of even numbered years and FFA National Trips will take place in the fall of odd numbered years.
