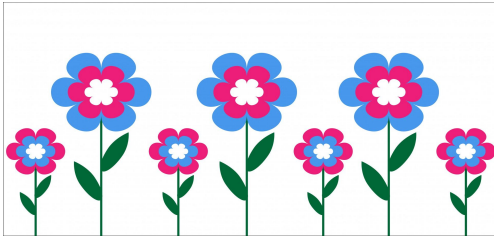


GOOD TO KNOW:

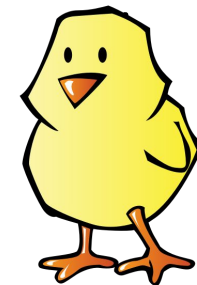
The darkling beetles have gone bye bye! We released them into the wild! Our butterflies have emerged, and the chicks are doing well!
