WHAT'S HAPPENING IN...

READING: We will continue in our Reading Mastery program and utilizing the Heggerty Phonemic Awareness Program during our Reading Intervention Time to focus on Priority Standards LA K.F.1.a, LA K.SL,2.a, LA FW.1.c, and LA K.W.1.b

SCIENCE: We will be completing a module on how the lights from the Sun effect the Earth's Surface. We will also be reading a Weekly Reader about mother and baby animals.

MATH: We will be continue Rocket Math daily, focusing on Priority Standard MA K.N.4.d I will add within 5. We will continue working on a spiral review of all we have learned this year. We will also be introducing money (pennies, dimes, nickels, quarters and paper money).

HANDWRITING: We will continue focusing on Priority Standard LA K.W.2.b I can adapt writing process to sustain engagement in short and long-term writing tasks and increasing length and complexity by writing by creating an Earth Day Art project. We will also begin working on our "End of Year Memory Book".

SOCIAL STUDIES: We have completed our Social Studies curriculum and will use this time to review any priority standards not met.

PBiS Focus: We will continue to review rules, procedures, and expectations about being in school.
