Student Driving and Parking

Students who drive to school are required to park their vehicles and leave them unoccupied until it is time to drive home. Students are to maintain a safe speed, maintain care and concern for others, and refrain from careless driving while utilizing their vehicle on school grounds. Administrative discretion will be used in the determination of whether or not a student violates the above rules. If a student is found to be in violation of such rules, the student may have their parking privileges and access to school grounds be modified to a certain location, revoked, suspended, the student may receive additional consequences, and/or receive a combination of such disciplinary action.

Students may not drive or have access to their vehicles during the school day without the expressed permission of their building principal or their designee. Students are to park appropriately and in the assigned areas on school property. Student parking shall not be permitted in bus loading zones. When the buses are loading or unloading, all vehicles must stop and wait for the loading or unloading process to be completed.

By driving a vehicle to school, students consent to having that vehicle searched by school officials if school officials have reasonable suspicion that such a search will reveal a violation of school rules.
