6005 Graduation Requirements & Awarding of Diploma

After the student has met the requirements for graduation, he or she is therefore entitled to a high school diploma. Graduation from the Central City Public School will be made on the recommendation of the Superintendent to the Board of Education, provided the pupil has completed the requirements as established by State Law, the Nebraska Department of Education and the Board of Education.

To be eligible for graduation from Central City High School and receive a high school diploma, a student must have earned a minimum of 230 semester hours of credit. Credit hours will be computed in accordance with the Nebraska Department of Education. Satisfactory completion of the following courses must be present in the candidate's academic record/transcript:

- Minimal requirements in the basic core academics of: 40 Credit Hours of English, 30 Credit Hours of Science, 30 Credit Hours of Social Studies, and 30 Credit Hours of Mathematics.
- 10 Credit Hours of Technology
- 5 Credit Hours of Art, Music, or Communications.
- 5 Credit Hours of Physical Education.
- 5 Credit Hours of Health.
- 5 Credit Hours of Personal Finance
- 70 Credit Hours of Elective Courses
- In addition, students must complete 20 Clock Hours of Community Service activities (generally the minimum of 5 clock hours per year) and 6 Clock Hours of On-Site Job Shadowing Experience (generally 3 clock hours during their Junior and Senior years).

The candidates for graduation shall be presented to the Board of Education for approval. A student who has not met the requirements for graduation, but who has attended school regularly may, with the recommendation of the Superintendent, be granted a Certificate of Completion.
