DISTRICT GOALS 2016-2017

Board/District Goals

Immediate:

- 1. Provide leadership opportunities for students and staff.
- 2. Continue focus on community, family, "branding", and the "Bison Way."
- 3. Begin to make transitions for a Career Pathway Initiative to include discussion regarding middle school curriculum exposure, molding courses into Career Academies, taking a look at graduation requirements, and scheduling.

Priority Goals:

- 1. Develop a positive school culture that promotes student excellence in academics, athletics, and in activities through a district wide approach of data analysis, transitions, curriculum items, and student services.
- 2. Continue to raise test scores in all curricular areas.
- 3. Research and analyze the Career Pathway Initiative by:
 - a. Defining the academic focus
 - b. Expanding current construction initiative
 - c. Expanding Dual Credit opportunities
 - d. Developing links with local and regional businesses
- 4. Conduct a facility needs assessment study that analyzes current facilities, looks at future needs, and evaluates current district grade structure.

Long-term Goals:

- 1. Implement a career pathways institute that expands student-learning opportunities in career fields that promote economic development in the region and supports community needs.
- 2. Develop a long-term plan for facilities that explore district needs, the future of education, and looks progressively at student needs.
