What's Happening in the Classroom...

READING: We will continue instruction in the Reading Mastery program and Heggerty Phonemic Awareness program. We are focusing on letter sounds, letter recognition, and blending/reading words. We are encouraging students to read with accuracy, fluency, and automaticity. Please ask your child to read their daily worksheets to you! Rapid reads and decodable books (sounds and words) may be coming home as well! (LA K.F.1.a I can identify all upper and lowercase letters of the alphabet in isolation and in connected text. & LA K.SL.2.a I can demonstrate appropriate speaking teachings for a variety of purpose and situations.)

SCIENCE: We will be reading some weekly readers to learn more about the topics we will be exploring on our field trip (raptors and bubbles).

MATH: We will continue Rocket Math. (Ma K.N.4.d I will add within 5. and I will subtract within 5.) We will be introducing the parts of a clock, telling time to the hour and telling time to the half hour.

HANDWRITING: We will be continue practicing writing our first and last names. We will continue journaling.

SOCIAL STUDIES: We have completed our unit. We will use this time for classroom read alouds.

PBiS: We will continue to review procedures and expectations for the different areas of our school.
