Dear Student:

Driver Education will again be offered this summer at Central City High School at a cost of \$275 for students from our district, or going to our high school next year, and \$315 for students out of the Central City district. The cost will cover the 28 hours of classroom instruction, as well as the 6 hours of driving and 6 hours of observation. Students must hold a valid permit by June 1, 2026 to enroll in the course. If the student does not hold a valid permit by June 1, they will not finish the course and no refunds will be issued.


If you are planning on enrolling in a Driver Education class this summer, you must complete the enclosed registration form and return it with \$137.50 down payment for students from our district and \$157.50 down payment from out of district students to the high school office by May 1st. The final payment is due on or before May 26, 2026. There will be a required Parent Meeting on Wednesday, May 13, at 7pm.

We are limited to 60 students for a total enrollment, 30 students in each class. When a session gets 30 students registered, it will be considered full and applications after that point will be placed in the alternate class. Those who apply early will have the best chance to get their choice of sessions. No enrollment is final until the down payment is received in the office.

The Driver's Education course is taught by Nebraska Department of Education certified teachers. Therefore, Central City High School students will earn elective high school credits as long as the student is entering high school or is enrolled in high school. Students will earn a grade of a P (Pass) for students earning a 70% or better; students who earn a 69% or lower will receive a F (Fail). Out-of-District students will earn credits and the grading will be dependent on the school's driver's education grading policy. If no policy exists, then the students will follow Central City Public School's policy.
